School will implement the ALERTNOW Rapid Notification Service in order to contact parents/guardians of students instantly, in the event of an emergency closing. A blue Emergency Closing Form has been sent home, asking what your child is to do if we should dismiss early. If we do not receive the form back indicating where your child(ren) is to go, we will conclude that you want your child(ren) to ride home as they normally are scheduled.

In any event, we implore you to listen to the following TV and radio stations for information about school closings. **Please** do not call school, this simply ties-up telephone lines that are needed to get information out. Also do not call school employees at home. Instead listen to the radio, TV or **log onto our website** for school closing information. In the event you do call school, a taped message will play indicating if there is school and other information you may need to know.
