Physical/Immunizations and Dental Exams

Immunization records must be on file by August 14, 2017, for all students in attendance. Physicals for all new students, Pre-Kindergarten, Kindergarten or 1st and 6th, dental exams for Kindergarten, 2nd and 6th, and comprehensive eye exams for Kindergarten or students new to the state of Illinois, must be turned in prior to the first day of school which is August 14, 2017.

Students whose physicals and immunizations are not turned in to the office will not be in compliance and will not be allowed to start the 17-18 school year. The office will be opened all summer (Monday through Friday) for parents to obtain or turn in their exam forms.
